Tights	N/A	Plain, skin-coloured, or dark green

Tie	Black and white School tie, properly tied with length just above waistband. Top button must be fastened	N/A
Pullover/Cardigan	Black, plain, V-neck, knitted with long sleeves. Can be worn in addition to blazer but not on its own	Dark green, plain, V-neck, knitted with long sleeves. Can be worn in addition to blazer but not on its own
Shoes	Formal plain black leather or simulated leather, with low heel. Coloured or canvas shoes/trainers/boots are not permitted	
Outdoor Clothing	Overcoat/raincoat/duffel-coat/anorak that is dark in colour. Students are not permitted to wear coats during lessons or inside the buildings during lesson transition (i.e. between registration and P1; P1 and P2; P4 and P5) Denim or combat jackets are not permitted Students are permitted to wear the School hoodie to and from school only	
Scarf	Any colour may be worn to and from school, but not within the School buildings during lessons or transition time	
Badges	Only authorised badges are permitted e.g. House badges, achievement badges	
Hair	No extremes of style (e.g. unnatural colouring or excessively short). Hair ornaments should be discrete in size, design and colour, including hairbands. Headdress worn for religious reasons must be black, green or white and nonpatterned
