**Success criteria:**

- Accurate drawing with light pencil
- Mixing your own colours with coloured pencil
- Adding texture with line.
- Writing about your copy in your own words.

Harmonious colours are found next to each other on the colour wheel. They are primary, secondary and tertiary colours that have a similar value. The Starry Night by Vincent Van Gogh shows a range of harmonious blues.

Using your knowledge of mixing colours with coloured pencils, copy the whole image or a part of The Starry Night that shows harmonious colours. Try to add textures too – use ideas from the last project to help you add hatching or mark making.
