

Verbs and Prepositions

Verbs that follow prepositions: when a verb directly follows a preposition, there is only one rule to remember – *the verb following a preposition remains in the infinitive.*

There is NO exception to this rule.

Antes de comer, me lavo las manos

Para recibir una A, necesitas trabajar

Después de comer, lavo los platos

Además de andar, me gusta correr

En vez de estudiar, voy a dormir

Pienso en conseguir un gato
