Do you have a good degree in a related subject area? Whether you are a recent graduate or someone looking to change career, our subject-specific SCITTs could be your step on the path to an enormously rewarding career.

Our subject-specific SCITTs are different from the traditional PGCE route. Trainees spend more time working in schools from the start and study the educational theory (the PGCE part) alongside teaching in the classroom. We offer:

- Weekly or fortnightly subject-specific training throughout the course from subject specialists at Oundle School
- The opportunity to build up your teaching very gradually
- Placement at two of our thirty partner schools in the area, enabling you to experience teaching in both independent and maintained sectors.



Excellence in specialist teacher training

Each trainee has an in-school mentor to guide and support them throughout the year. The PGCE is provided by Buckingham University online.



Trainees attend 11 training days across the year at Oundle School, which are delivered by experienced language teachers and PGCE tutors. The PGCE part of the course is provided by Sheffield Hallam University and takes a blended approach.
