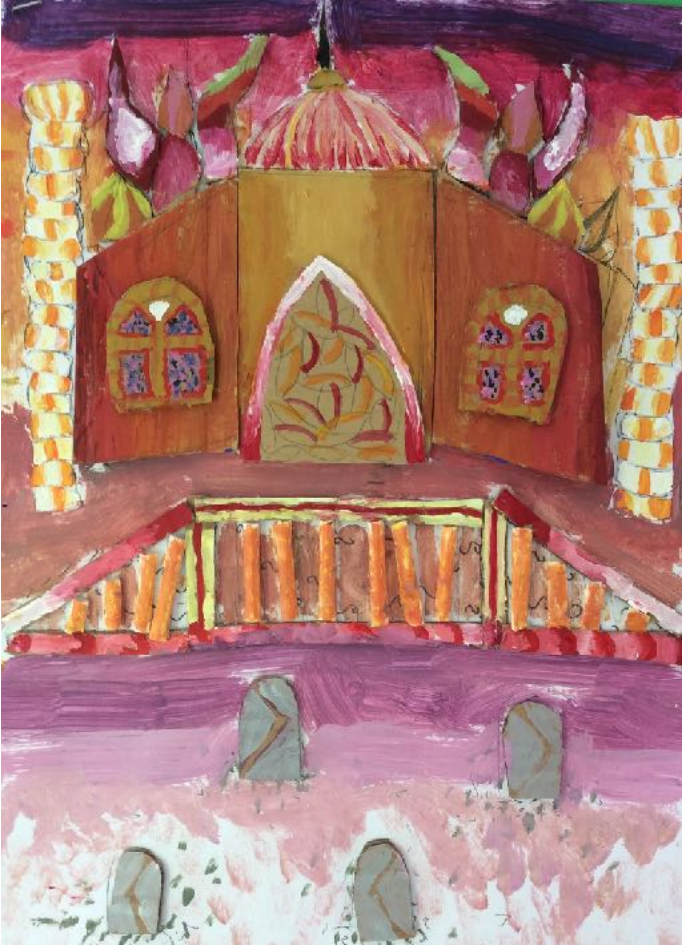
NEW FIELD NOW IN USE

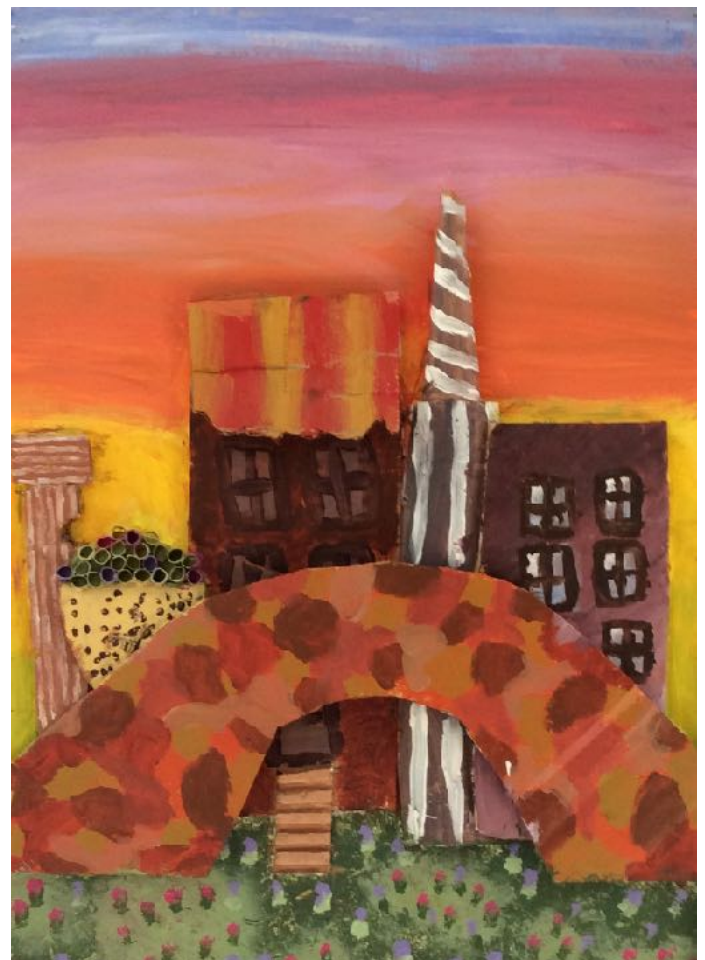
